



Privacy Policy

JPC InfoNet Limited Trading as Cloud Heroes Ltd ("We") are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy.

This policy sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect from you, or that you provide to us, will be processed by us. Please read the following carefully to understand our views and practices regarding your personal data and how we will treat it. By visiting this website and by entering into any agreement for supply of products and services with us, you are accepting and consenting to the practices described in this policy.

For the purpose of the Data Protection Act 1998 (the Act), the data controller is JPC InfoNet Limited Trading as Cloud Heroes Ltd of Suite 2, Bryer Ash Business Park, Trowbridge, Wiltshire, United Kingdom, BA14 8AW.

We use an in-house analytics system to provide basic usage metrics on our website. Your IP address may be used to help identify you and to gather broad demographic information such as country of residence. This information, provided by your web browser, may be provided to our support or tech team should you complete any contact forms or live chat requests on our website. All information is stored securely on internal Cloud Heroes servers and will only be used in accordance with this policy and our terms & conditions.

Our website's contact forms provide users the means to give us contact information which we use to send users information about our company or services. The customer's contact information is also used to contact visitors or customers when necessary, or occasionally to provide relevant information about our products and services. Any marketing mailings will give recipients the option to opt-out by using the provided unsubscribe link or contacting us directly.

We only rely on our own, highly-secure systems for any internal data storage except for customer communications (see below regarding MailChimp in respect of customer communications).

Our website or customer portal may contain links to external sites and Cloud Heroes is not responsible for the privacy practices or the content of these sites.

We may use and share your details for the collection of any debts you owe to us. This may include the use of debt collection organisations to collect any unpaid debts on our behalf.

- Selected third parties including:
 - business partners, suppliers and sub-contractors for the performance of any contract we enter into with them or you;
 - Quick Books, our online accounting software provider;
 - MailChimp, for the purposes of providing email campaign management services. Mailchimp is based in the USA and is therefore outside of the European Economic Area. We have been careful to select a sub-contractor that adheres to the same standards of security and integrity as ourselves, are SOC II compliant and PCI DSS certified. We will disclose your personal information to third parties:

- If JPC InfoNet Limited Trading as Cloud Heroes Ltd or substantially all of its assets are acquired by a third party, in which case personal data held by it about its customers will be one of the transferred assets.
